Brief:

A. Cure and Care Service Centre (CCSC) Kerinchi:

Distance: 15KM

Community Rehabilitation Treatment Program is an aftercare program provided to clients who have completed the program in the institution.

After rebranding from (National Anti-Drug Agency)NADA Service Centre, Cure and Care Service Centre or known as CCSC has taken over the role played to providing treatment and rehabilitation services to the target groups through programs such as Psychosocial Counseling Program, Social Support Groups, Relapse Prevention Group, Family Program, Early Recovery Program, etc. In addition, CCSC also serves as a reference and advisory services, sports and leisure facilities, as well as Methadone Program as a supportive treatment to clients.

CCSC focuses on service that is attentive to provide treatment and rehabilitation programs that can meet the needs of the client's recovery. Establishment of CCSC is across hot spot areas targeted expanding access treatment and rehabilitation services to the community on a voluntary basis to all Malaysians who have drug problems.

B. Cure & Care 1Malaysia Clinic

Distance: 20KM

The Cure & Care 1Malaysia Clinic was officially launched by National Anti-Drug Agency (NADA) on 1st July 2010 at the Anti-Narcotics Rehabilitation Centre in Sungai Besi, Kuala Lumpur. This clinic provides open access services to drug abusers, drug users, their families, employers and individuals with drug problems. Harm reduction programs run under C&C Clinic include Methadone Maintenance Therapy program, HIV Screening and ARV treatment for the clients.

C. Infectious Disease Clinic, Hospital Sungai Buloh (ID Clinic)

The clinic established in year 2006 known as the largest clinic treating HIV/AIDS patients in Klang Valley. The head of the clinic is Datuk Dr Christopher Lee and currently they have approximately 6000 outpatients registered for several treatments, which include HIV/AIDS. The clinic operates from Monday to Friday.

Some of our programmes are;

1. Wellness advance care clinic by specialist nurse counsellors on Tuesdays
2. Extended services for HIV stable patients on Saturdays
3. Combined HIV/Hepatitis co-infections programme once a month
4. Training centre for post graduates in Infectious Disease Sub-Specialities
5. Training centre for post basic HIV nurse counsellor programme

IKHLAS addresses the pressing needs of the street based drug user community in urban area. They provide the services to PWIDs under harm reduction program around Kuala Lumpur since 2006. IKHLAS provides clean Needle and Syringes to PWIDs through outreach, referral services to the ARV treatment and Methadone Maintenance Therapy & support group session.

In SEED, the NGO stay true to motto - Nobody Gets Left Behind. SEED supports and provide HIV/AIDS prevention services to marginalized community mainly sex workers and transgender.
